POLICIES AND GUIDELINES

To be considered, participants must adhere to the following policies and guidelines:

- At least one principal of the proposed business must be a California State University, Fresno or partnering community college student in good standing.
- The lead contact member of the team must be a California State University, Fresno or partnering community college student in good standing.
- Companies that have launched before **JANUARY 1, 2009** are not eligible to compete.
- Entry forms and submittals must be received by **5 PM, APRIL 6, 2010**.
